Recognizing Excellence among OHS Professionals begins with You! The Canadian Society of Safety Engineering (CSSE) is made up of over 3,500 dedicated members who commit their days (and in many cases ...nights) to the protection of millions of Canadian workers. The CSSE Recognizing Excellence Awards program provides a framework to pay special recognition to the extraordinary efforts and achievements of CSSE members.

The awards for **Outstanding Service to CSSE (Volunteer of the Year)** are presented to CSSE members who demonstrate their volunteer commitment to the CSSE at the chapter, regional and/or national levels.

For this award, Chapter Chairs or a Chapter Executive member submits a nomination for the Chapter level; RVPs nominate for the Regional level; and the Board of Directors nominate for the National level. This award does not include nominations from members and winners are not cascaded from the chapter to the national level. The lack of progression is to encourage nominations for volunteers at all levels of the CSSE. Our volunteer leadership members (ex. Chapter Chairs, RVP, etc.) are in the best position to identify the individuals that are first to lend a hand or put in the extra effort needed to make the CSSE a success at all levels.
