

Nominations Now Open for NEW CSSE Board of Directors and Regional Council

On October 6, 2021, in a Special Meeting of Members, the new Governance structure and By-Laws of the CSSE were approved. As a result, CSSE members will be electing a new Governance Board as well as Regional Vice-Presidents who will sit on a new Regional Council in this year's CSSE National Elections.

The election cycle this year will be as follows:

Nominations Open November 8-22
Task Force Vetting Closes December 1
Elections Open December 6-13
Winners Announced December 15
AGM December 16

The eligibility requirements have changed as well as the candidate vetting process. Please see the attached documents for details and further explanation below.

What positions are up for election?

There are a total of 10 positions up for election. Seven of the open positions are on the new CSSE Governance Board; 3 Regional Vice-President positions are on the new Regional Council. View the attached chart for a visual of the new structure and available positions.

2021 Regional Council Positions up for election:

If you like to roll up your sleeves, support local and regional events, increase member engagement and member value, then the NEW Role of a **Regional Vice President** on the **Regional Council** might be perfect for you!

- Regional Vice President Alberta, Northwest Territories, Nunavut
- Regional Vice President Ontario, Quebec
- Regional Vice President British Columbia, Yukon

NOTE: These RVP positions are for a two-year term December 2021 to December 2023.

2021 National Board Positions up for election:

- Director at Large (x4)
- Vice President Governance and Human Resources
- Vice President Finance
- Vice President Regional Affairs



NOTE: ALL Board positions will be for a one-year term from December 2021 to December 2022 as per the transition document. Full terms will begin with the 2022 Board Elections.

Director at Large:

If you are a strategic thinker, are interested in mapping the vision for the future of the CSSE, then the new position of a **Director at Large** on the National Board might be your ideal position. **The Director at Large** positions are meant to be introductory positions on the Board for members to familiarize themselves with a Governance Board and to provide insight, perspective and assistance where needed to the Board. Skills such as financial literacy, post-secondary educational experience, strategic planning, good governance, diversity and inclusion, policy and procedural experience are all examples of strengths and skills that the Board needs to build a strong and sustainable future.

There are 4 Director at Large positions on the Board open to be filled this year.

Vice President Positions:

The positions of Vice President Governance and Human Resources, Vice President Finance and Vice President Regional Affairs are new roles, and along with the President, make up the new Board's Executive Council.

The position of **Vice President Governance and Human Resources** should have experience in Board and Governance as they will be tasked with the oversight of the G&HR Committee and continuing to build upon the CSSE's journey to good governance and strategic direction.

The position of **Vice President Finance** needs to be financially literate and have experience in managing large and complex budgets. This position will be tasked with the oversight of the F&A Committee and ensuring that future budgets are balanced and achieved.

The position of **Vice President Regional Affairs** should be familiar with the operations, needs, initiatives and goals of the Chapters and Regions of the CSSE. This position will be tasked with the oversight of the **Regional Council** and Task Forces of the CSSE. The 5 RVP positions report up through the VP Regional Affairs.

How do I apply?

Nominations for all positions must have the signature of the candidate indicating acceptance of the nomination, plus the signatures of at least two (2) CSSE voting* members in good standing** as nominators. For the position of Regional Vice President, those nominators must reside in the regional jurisdiction.

Once a nomination has been received, the candidate will receive a package requesting information on the required and desired competencies for review by the Nomination & Elections Committee.

*A "voting Member" means a Regular Member, a Professional Member, a Retired Member, or a Life Member.

**Good standing means membership fees are paid up to date and the member is not in Grace Period.
