Mandatory minimum PPE requirements on site include: safety boots, hearing protection, protective eyewear, hard hat, and escape respirator.

PPE must be worn at all times in all operating areas onsite.



#### **Jewellery**

Jewellery, rings, wrist watches, dangling neckwear or similar items that could become entangled shall not be worn.



#### **Smoking**

Smoking/Vaping is permitted in designated areas



#### Camera/Video

Taking photos or videos is prohibited without authorization.



### **Company Network**

Electronic devices may not be connected to company network without authorization.



#### Alarms

Obey alarm signals and follow instructions. Audible alarm with red/white flashing lights indicates "must evacuate" area immediately.



Walk in designated aisle ways and do not take shortcuts. Be alert to floor hazards and vehicle traffic.



## **Heavy Equipment In Operation**

Pay attention to your surroundings. Forklift and heavy equipment operate onsite.



## **Environmental Spill Response**

Report all spills to your Irving Pulp & Paper sponsor immediately.



## **Electromagnetic Fields**

Electromagnetic Fields are present in certain areas. Access to these areas is prohibited for persons wearing Pacemakers.



#### **Chemicals & Hazardous Materials**

WHMIS controlled product Safety Data Sheets must accompany chemicals brought onsite. Copy of SDS must be delivered to Security Gate or Stores receiving.



### Radioactive devices

Radioactive devices are in service in various parts of the mill.



#### **Evacuation**

In an evacuation leave area by nearest exits and escape routes only. DO NOT use elevators.



#### **Muster Stations**

Make your way to designated muster points and await further instructions. Report missing colleagues to muster coordinator.



# RULES OF THE ROAD

## SIGNAGE, TRAFFIC SIGNALS, AND ROAD MARKINGS

Generally, all signage, traffic signals, and road markings are consistent with those found on public roads and must be followed.

## **RIGHT OF WAY**

On an industrial site, right of way must be granted to larger industrial equipment, for example, trains and bucket loaders will always have right of way over passenger vehicles and small mobile equipment.

On the Irving Pulp & Paper site **Right of Way** precedence is granted as follows:

- 1. Train
- 2. Loader
- 3. Transport Trucks
- 4. Forklifts, Mobile Equipment, Machinery
- 5. Pedestrians
- 6. Passenger vehicles

## **PASSING**

Passing is prohibited unless the vehicle in front ceases to be in motion and signals the vehicle behind that it is safe to pass.

## **SPEED LIMITS**

Speed limits on the site are set at 20 kilometres per hour (km/h), unless otherwise posted.



## **PEDESTRIANS**

Use of marked walkways and protected travel ways is required. Wearing high visibility clothing is strongly encouraged in all areas and is mandatory within Wood Yard boundaries.



## **DESIGNATED PARKING**

Specific parking areas are designated for private vehicles and other areas are designated for site vehicles, and equipment. All other areas are "No Parking", and vehicles parked in these areas are subject to towing.

## Parking Exemptions are granted by a Job Sponsor and issued by Security.
