



Industrial Hygiene Technician – Contract-based

EHS Partnerships Ltd. is seeking qualified occupational health and safety technicians for a short-term, casual contract to provide health and safety support at an EHS^P Client site in Northern Alberta.

Working under the guidance of EHS^P's senior industrial hygienists and the Client, successful applicants will have the following key responsibilities:

- Travel to Client site in Fort McMurray.
- Conduct onsite sampling, analysis, monitoring, and surveying for a variety of occupational health and safety stressors. These may include NORM, BTEX, RCF, airborne metals, mercury vapour, and other contaminants as required by the Client.
- Fill out field sheets as required.
- Maintain communication with EHS^P's senior industrial hygienists.
- Be flexible with work hours. Work schedule may include 15 days, with 12-hour shifts.

The work will start late March and run into the middle of April. To accommodate the work, EHS^P will provide rental cars, hotels, meal allowances, personal protective equipment, and other tools as needed.

The successful candidates will be required to complete an online general safety certification course and pass a drug and alcohol test as a condition of being allowed access to the Client's site. Additional orientation will be provided by EHS^P's senior industrial hygienists as needed.

Qualifications of the successful applicant will include:

- Completion of post-secondary education in occupational health and safety, a degree in the sciences, or related field is required.
- Some oil and gas work experience required.
- Background in safety, hazardous materials, or industrial hygiene is preferred.
- Familiar with applicable occupational health and safety legislation and best practices, and able to interpret and apply regulatory requirements.
- Must be flexible with work schedule.
- Willingness to learn new skills and expand knowledge through duties assigned.
- Ability to multi-task, organize, and prioritize work.
- Ability to successfully work with a team.
- Excellent communication skills is a must.
